COURSE DESCRIPTION - In this course you'll learn how the legal system relates to issues affecting family members. You will learn about the roles and responsibilities of the federal government and provincial governments with respect to family law.

General Outcomes:

2. examine laws related to relationships
3. describe the roles of parent/guardian, authorities and others who have an interest in the child; e.g., neglect, abuse, adoption, welfare of the child, where the child lives
4. investigate laws related to preparing your will and estate
5. demonstrate basic competencies
6. make personal connections to the cluster content and processes to inform possible pathway choices
