



Student Expectations Summer School 2024

Summer School is an abbreviated semester. Beginning on July 2, please check our teachers' onsite schedules to see their availability. Teachers are available both onsite and via email for help at our campuses in Airdrie, Chestermere, and Cochrane. You are not required to work on campus but are strongly encouraged to do so, as the result is on average a 30% increase in the success rate for students. Some tests may be required to be written in person at one of our campus locations.

You are a fit for Summer School if:

- You can be physically present to take the exams/tests and in person writing assignments on campus.
- You are able to put in 4-5 hours a day 5 days a week in July (each core course takes about 80 – 100 hours to complete).
- You are able to complete the first module in your course(s) by July 5. Courses open to students May 21 in <https://moodle.rockyview.ab.ca>

You should not take a Summer School course if:

- You are working during July (unless taking Work Experience)
- You are going to be out of the Province during the month of July
- You do not have access to a computer or the internet

Please read the following to be aware of Summer School deadlines and school policies. Upon successful registration, you will receive an email with your confirmation on or after March 18, course instructions, and Summer School expectations. **Please respond to this email acknowledging you have read and understand these expectations.**

1. Deadlines outlined for Summer School are final; no extensions will be given. (See Summer School 2024 Calendar for all important dates/deadlines.) You are responsible for setting final exam writing times with your teacher.
2. Core courses will require a final exam in person at the school location.
3. Students taking a core course will be required to write some assessments in person at the school location. As the courses open May 21, students may wish to get a head start. Teachers will be available starting July 2 for support and instruction. All in person assessments will happen on/after July 2.
4. Parents/guardians are responsible to provide any necessary transportation.
5. If you have not completed the first unit/module in your course(s) by July 5, you will be withdrawn.
6. There are no accommodations for students with IPPs in Summer School except audio version of diploma exams only. Please notify your teacher if this applies to you.
7. You are expected to check your @rvschools email account daily for information.
8. Behavior should be appropriate for a school learning environment. Respectful behavior and school appropriate attire at all times is expected.
9. If you are taking a diploma course, you must register yourself to write the diploma exam (exams in August 2024). To register you can do so through MyPass – you can register to write at Rocky View Schools Education Centre 26541 Chinook Winds Drive SW, Airdrie (choose 0404 Airdrie Learning Connection writing centre). Your deadline to register is July 3.
10. All school materials should be returned to your school library (or where you borrowed it from) at the end of August 2024.
11. If a student has borrowed material from an RVSCLC campus, those materials can be returned to the campus on the day of your final exam or by August 30. If these materials are not returned by this deadline, the \$150 cheque for textbook deposits will be cashed (or credit card charged) and if the total cost owing is any amount over \$150, that amount will be charged to the credit card.
