This is a tool to track marks/credits, diploma exams/results, as well as order transcripts and apply for post secondary. Visit myPass.alberta.ab.ca to request access. DO NOT use your @rvschools.ab.ca email. Use a personal email address to create this account.
- -Parents and students ensure that you know how to log into PowerSchool. PowerSchool is the information hub for your child's academic progress. If you need help accessing PowerSchool please contact Nadine Alexander for support.
- -SAIT is having an open house for students on Oct.18th. If there are any students interested in registering for this event, please speak with Yvonne Paschalis (Guidance Counsellor) as soon as possible.
- -Octoberfest Meal: The students in Foods will be preparing a special lunch on October 16th for all students and staff.

- -Pumpkin Carving Event: All students are welcome to participate in pumpkin carving on October 30th. All the supplies will be provided at the school. Please bring your creativity!
- -Students are invited to wear their costumes to school on October 31st.
