A message from your administrators:

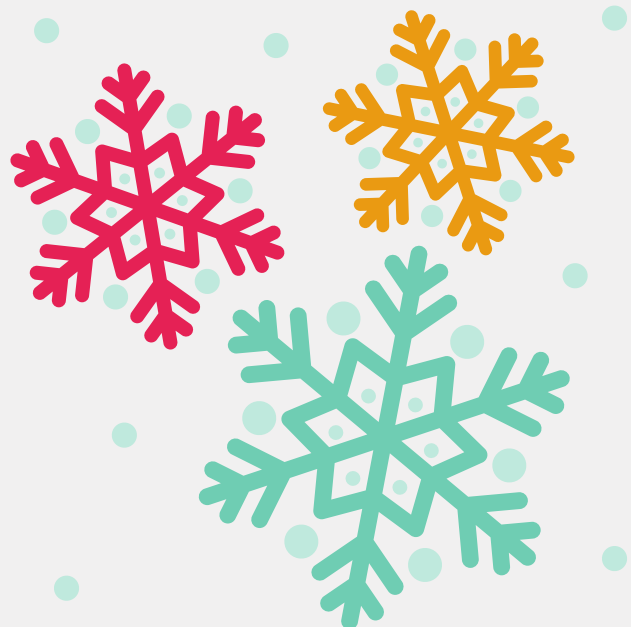
