RVSCLC Cochrane would like to Showcase one of our exceptional students. Hannah Mahon is a Grade 12 student attending CLC to do some upgrading. Hannah had a very busy, exciting summer, doing a volunteer assignment through IVHQ for 4 weeks in a childcare project in Kenya. Her and 3 other volunteers (from all over the world) stayed with Kenyan women who opened their homes to volunteers from that organization. She volunteered with a special needs class in a school just outside of Thika, where children ranged with disabilities from academic challenges to having cerebral palsy. Her and the other volunteers worked with the kids from 8:30-4 every day, teaching religion, English, social and math classes, playing games with them and walking them home from school. She did a 4 day safari in the Maasai Village and participated in an outreach weekend, where her and other volunteers visited the African slums and the schools within them.
